 - b. [Email](#) to families via [MyEd](#) before distributing report cards.
2. **Written descriptive comments** that clearly match/reflect the **Proficiency Scale** in the [ERC](#)
3. **Record of Ongoing Communication of Student Learning** (ROCSL) in the [ERC](#).
4. **Core Competencies** acknowledgement of student self-assessment in the [ERC](#).
