


# NOIIE Inquiry Top-Up Grants

A guide to applying for and supporting your inquiry.



# Network of Inquiry and Indigenous Education (NOIIE)

NOIIE provides a \$500 grant to school teams in British Columbia that utilize the **Spiral of Inquiry** to inspire professional learning.

In December, school teams can apply for the grant and with the support from district network leaders, the Spiral of Inquiry will be used throughout the year as a framework to guide ongoing professional conversations.

In June, teams are required to submit a Case Study to share their learning. The Case Study is a pre-requisite to receiving the grant from NOIIE in October of the following year.



## **Spiral of Inquiry**

Inquiry is about being open to new learning and taking informed action.



# **Application Process**

### **NOIIE Inquiry Grant:** \$500

This **NOIIE inquiry** is based on the first four stages of the Spiral of Inquiry: scanning, focusing, developing a hunch & learning.

During the scanning stage, analyze baseline data to choose a focus. The baseline data will be re-visited to check on student growth throughout the inquiry.

#### Submit Proposal by Dec. 17, 2021

 NOIIE will only approve 1 grant per school, consult your principal before submitting your application

#### Submit Case Study by June 2022

• Email a copy of your receipt

Oct. 2022: \$500 deposited into school account

The **case study** will include the last two stages: taking action & checking

### **NLPS Top-Up Grant:** \$500

To be eligible for an additional \$500 top-up in **January 2022**, ensure your inquiry meets the following criteria:

- Focus is data-driven
- School teams include a minimum of 3 teachers
  - + 1 principal or vice principal
- School Teams will:
  - 1. Email a copy of your NOIIE Application receipt by December 17, 2021
  - 2. Participate in NLPS networking session on March 3, 2022
  - 3. Invite District Inquiry Partner to attend a school NOIIE meeting in April 2022
  - 4. Present at the NLPS Showcase of Learning on June 9, 2022
  - 5. Email a copy of your NOIIE Case Study receipt by June 30, 2022

Note: There is one top-up grant available per school.
