

Coordinated Team Response

A **Coordinated Team Response** is required when a student demonstrates any level three behaviours. This intervention ensures a consistent and coordinated staff approach.

Team Lead is the team member working directly with the student who will initiate staff response. Team lead is a fluid role as it may change from primary EA to a member of the SBT, as needed.

Response Team includes members activated to support a student who is becoming unsafe to self or others. A school-based team member must be the first in to respond. Based on student need, some members may be responsible to assume a variety of positions (i.e., note-taker, communicator, etc.)

Team Lead Responsibilities	Response Team Responsibilities
