



School Tour: Information for Families



Welcome to Nanaimo Ladysmith School District (NLPS)

When you and your child get an invitation to your neighborhood school to come in for a tour of the school you can expect the following:

- To meet the Principal, Vice-principal, counsellor or the teacher, and English Language Learner (ELL) Teacher
- To find out where the important places in the school are with a map (bathrooms, classroom, playground, library, office, etc.)
- Emergency Drills will be explained (sometimes these can have loud warning sounds, but it is just for safety practice)
- You will get information about:
 - Bell schedule: when school starts and ends, when lunch is.
 - Permission Forms: about using the computer and going on field trips
 - School supplies and backpack
 - School's phone number and email if your child is going to be absent

Our priority for your children is making sure they feel safe and connected to other people as soon as possible.

There will not be talk about homework for the first few days, we want them to get used to the school setting and routines. We want them to learn who can help them and to start to make friends.
