



Elementary Outreach: A Tier 3 Support

Elementary Outreach is an intensive, individualized, and collaborative support for our students not attending school. The Inclusion-Outreach Team (IOT) will work closely with school teams, families, and community partners to create a plan that best meets the needs of the student. A coordinated and consistent approach is essential in providing wrap-around care. ***The focus will be on providing explicit skill building and supporting the transition back to school.***



Inclusion -Outreach Team

Completes fulsome intake with school teams and families

Provides explicit skill building opportunities in the community and school setting

Coordinates and enhances community supports for student and family

Consistently communicates with school team and family

Monitor and reports on student progress with respect to outreach opportunities



School Team

Develops and maintains an NLPS integration plan

Partners with IOT in completing intake

Communicates with IOT school or class events that foster connection

Collaborates with IOT and coordinates academic programming

Works with the IOT to support student transition

Formally reports on student progress



Caregivers

Partners with IOT in completing intake

Collaborates with team in developing child -centered goals and programming

Works with IOT in accessing community supports, when there is a need

Communicates with IOT any needs, concerns, or challenges
