## Getting Started

The [link](#) to the EAssess database can be found on the Intranet page or on the Learning Portal.

Teachers can sign in using the same username & password as your email: first.last or firstinitiallastname.

## Too Much Stuff

Click on the **three dots** at the top of a column.

In the dropdown menu, choose the columns you wish to view, print and/or download.

## Where to begin?

Choose a subtest by hovering over the column titles. Click on the "null" adjacent to the student name to start entering student responses.

**Check** boxes for each correct response. Correct responses will be counted and automatically entered into the spreadsheet. If a student scores 0 correct, write "0" in the *notes* and "Save Note"

## Nonsense Words Shortcut

Use the button on the home page to get the **word view**.

Teachers will be able to see the entire and the responses will populate into the corresponding columns in the spreadsheet.
